Syracuse Hancock International Airport Three-year DBE Goal Consultation

As a recipient of U.S. DOT funding, administered through the FAA, Syracuse Hancock International Airport is required to comply with the DBE Program. Overall Goal Setting, requires consultation with minority, women's and general contractor groups, community organizations, and other organizations to obtain information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses, the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs, and the efforts to establish a level playing field for the participation of DBEs in construction to establish a DBE goal for future federally funded projects at the airport.


